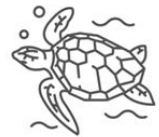

Discover	Discover history, faith, and tradition and how global changes are altering this way of life.



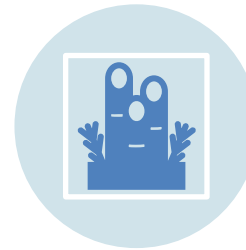
Tailored Experiences

Our program can include themed activities and challenges to bring classroom learning to life.



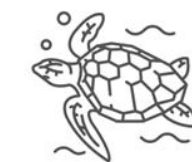
Undertake a community service project, clean a beach, plant coral, paint a building.

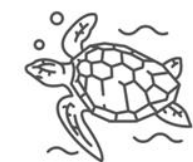

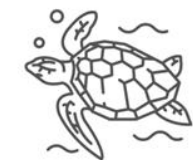

Our People



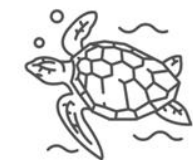
Allen Burton is an educator and social enterpriser. Allen is your first point of contact to discuss how your school can connect curriculum with The Island Classroom experience!

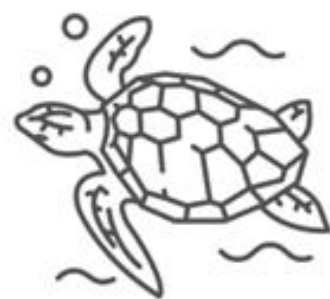
Our People

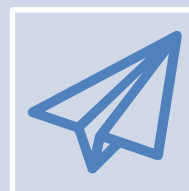
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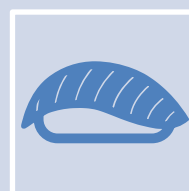
